**1. Products of Animal Origin**

(Common Health Entry Documents (CHED-P) are required).

- **For Products of Animal Origin From New Zealand (see Annex I)**
- **Destruction Charges for Products of Animal Origin**  
£0.80 per kilogram.
- **Out of Hours Charge**  
Where a regular out of hours service is required, prior agreement will be required. The minimum Out of Hours Charge per agent is £320.90 divided equally over the number of consignments. After three hours, an additional charge of £107.00 per hour will be incurred.

**Charges arising from additional official controls (in accordance with Article 28 of Regulation (EC) 882/2004).** Activities that exceed normal control activities include the taking and analysis of samples as well as other controls that are required to check the extent of a problem, to verify whether corrective action has been taken, or to detect and/or substantiate non-compliance.

Microbiological sampling of products in the DPE Inspection Room	<b>£35.50</b>
Lack of prenotification, where official activities have to be carried out in order to get a consignment ready for inspection at the Border Control Post (BCP)	<b>£70.10</b>

- **Destruction Charges for Non-Animal Origin Products (including products not covered by a CHED-D but where official controls have been carried out)**  
£0.70 per kilogram.

Where goods are detained at an External Temporary Storage Facility (ETSF), they may be destroyed there at the importer's expense, under the supervision of the relevant local authority.

- **Voluntarily Surrendered Goods**  
CHED-Ds which are selected for physical examination, but are **voluntarily surrendered for destruction at Gatwick without being sampled**, will be charged at **£48.90 plus £0.70 per kilogram** for destruction.

#### **4. Organic products**

- £48.90 for organics checks and the endorsement of a Certificate of Inspection.

The charges are made in accordance with Article 27 of Regulation (EC) 882/2004 on official controls performed to ensure the verification of compliance with feed and food law, animal health and animal welfare rules.

£285.64 per consignment over 46 tonnes
