The prevention of crime and disorder

Anjelique Bar employs 4 SIA Doorman on Friday and Saturdays to.

- SIA Door Team will have Body Worn Cameras.
- Patrons will be required to be seated at socially distanced tables and table service will be provided.
- All alcohol consumed in the outside area will be decanted into shatterproof drinking vessels.
- The area is cordoned off via barriers.
- CCTV monitoring the full area.
- All bottles and glasses are to be removed from public areas as soon as the contents have been drunk or are empty.
- Bottle bins for collection or empty bottles will not be accessible to members of the public.

b)

c) Public safety

- All staff members have been trained in fire and emergency evacuation procedures.
- The manager will perform periodic noise checks outside the building on all sides, with specific attention to those sides closest to residential properties.
- 24 hour recorded CCTV
- Only shatterproof glasses to be used
- Anjelique Bar will employ an additional SIA Doorman on Friday and Saturdays to monitor the outside drinking area.
- Customers will be registered on an I.D Scanner that enter the Anjelique Bar premises.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- Staff will encourage customers to engage in the outdoor area quietly, recognizing the needs of local residents and businesses.
- The licensee shall ensure that prominent clear and legible notices are displayed at all exits requesting customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- Regular sound checks to be performed.

e) The protection of children from harm

The premises operate a proof of age policy. No under 18's are allowed onto the premises.

Notes for Guidance

This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates. If you wish to make that type of change to the premises licence, you should make a new premises licence application under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

1. **You do not have to pay a fee** if the only purpose of the variation for which you are applying is to avoid becoming liable for the late-night levy
2. **Describe the premises.** For example, the type of premises, its general situation and layout and any other information which could be relevant to the licensing objectives. Where your application includes off-supplies of alcohol and you intend to provide a place of consumption of these off-supplies of alcohol, you must include a description of where the place will be and its proximity to the premises.

 - **Indoor sporting events:** no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
 - **Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment:** no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - **Live music:** no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
 - **Recorded Music:** no licence permission is required for:
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.

- any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
 - **Dance:** no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
 - **Cross activity exemptions:** no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
