Loppets Road	Restructured due to lack of pavilion and toilets. The only sport that we can regularly have on loppets is junior football as customers are used to not having those facilities. Plenty of other sites nearby, Gainsborough Rd, Tilgate Park (dog walking and play), Southgate and Furnace Green PF and conservation area. Land locked area with no other provision really providing a field site.
Furnace Green	Nestled between Furnace Green and Maidenbower. Sites is out of the way to edge of neighbourhood with limited access by public transport. Lacks character and identity. Generally only used by FG residents, but there is limited access to other sites nearby. Nearest is Gainsborough and Tilgate Park
Grattons	A large diverse site accommodating both formal and informal sport, and play provision. The site has been used for community events such as relay for life and football tournaments. The conservation area is an SSCI site and managed mostly by Gatwick Green Space. Model aeroplane club use the site regularly. There is limited access to other nearby sites nearest open space is Worth park gardens. Demand for site is likely to increase if the North East Sector development progresses.
Knapp	Site is isolated from main access roads with residents as main users. Site is open, flat and uninviting of primary value to local dog walkers and play area users.
Three Bridges (Jubilee Field)	A disconnected site with two fields and Three Bridges Football club separating them. The site also has the TB Cricket club who lease their pitch one of the few self managed sites in the town. The site suffers from significant antisocial behaviour connected to homelessness population in the area. However residents participated in the design and location of the new play area. The car park is constantly full with commuters preventing park users from accessing the site by car.
Northgate	Open plan site well overlooked by road users and houses. Close to the town centre which provides a good foothall of usage. However there are few open spaces nearby which makes it a valuable site for the community. The open space provides direct access to the bluebell walk and the main footpath into the town centre.
Cherry Lane	Large diverse site accommodating most sports including an ADPG, Bowls, Cricket Club, Allotments. Interest from Tennis Club to permanently lease the courts. The site is starting to be used more for local community event the possibility of being the site for the Towns first BMX track. Site is very close to County Oak and the Manor Royal industrial estate, so could be scope for more facilities to support the businesses here. Particularly as open space provision within the industrial estate area is diminishing. The site however is very isolated compared with other sites within the town and access is poor through a minor road with lots of parked cars. There is plenty of spare underused space on this site as there a number of adjoining fields which could be utilised for other activities without negative impact on the quality of provision.
Willoughby Fields	Site primarily for the use of Crawley Rugby club and also an SSSI which is well managed. The area also accommodates a privately run bowls club. Located on the outskirts of the town, easily accessible, but quite remote and isolated in parts.
Ifield Green	Old site covered by Ifield conservation area. Part of which is classified as common land. Ifield cricket club and Chase Fitness are currently lessees. Site has historical significance with an old mill adjacent to the main sports club buildings. Site also has a recently renovated and enhanced play area. New housing developments nearby have increased the foothall and improved visibility and security of the site.
Ewhurst	Summarised as a field separated by a single line of trees and an underused play area which is also regularly flooded. However the football pitches are very popular as they are level and well drained. Although close to a residential area the site appears isolated as it is surrounded by hedges and has the main A23 running alongside the eastern side of the site.
West Green	One of the best parks/playing fields because it is able to serve both these puposes. Of high value to residents who do not have easy access to other spaces within the town centre area. There is a wide diversity of users which serves the need of the local community well. These include, bowls, tennis, cricket, football, social clubs (Ram, Labour and RHS). There has been recent consultation undertaken which has identified that the site is valued for it's quiet tranquility. However the play requires improvement. The car park has also undergone major renovation to improve the drainage and surface quality.
Goffs	One of the best parks with a unique sports provision with the towns only pitch and putt. There is also a model railway and club that participate in the very active Friends Group. The park is of high value to both local residents and residents from other parts of the town. It also provides important open space for the central part of the densely populated Town Centre. The park facilities have been developed with resident consultation and capital expenditure in excess of 600K has been spent improving the infrastructure and provision. The park has some of the best play provision within the town catering for all ages, including teenagers as well as areas of conservation. The park has a regular staff presence especially in the spring, summer and autumn. This venue is also preferred for large events for example the Crawley Carnival.
Gossops Green	Small playing field for the neighbourhood which tucked away amongst houses and the A23. Not a very interesting site but the play area and open space serve the local children as there are limited other play facilities nearby.
Breezehurst	Brand new community building with sports changing facilities which is currently not well used. The site used to house the pitch for American Football but this is no longer used and use of the other football pitches has not increased given the new community building so remains consistent with other sites. Site is isolated and does not feel secure. There are many other options for openspace within a short distance of the site
Bewbush the Green	Originally built as a cricket pavilion, but this has been detrimentally affected due to the need to install palisade fencing to deter vandalism. However the site is small enough provide a good piece of open space within this part of the neighbourhood with houses positioned around it helping the site feel overlooked for the users.
Western Strip	Very isolated strip of land on the edge of development. Will be come increasingly important with the proposed west of bewbusy development. However atm a field with two football pitches with play areas at either end. The site is position across a streamline and therefore visibility sense of security is compromised. It does however provide access to the footpaths and land beyond crawley used by dog walkers
Creasys	Two pitched sized areas of land that now have no use as the pavilion was redeveloped into the Surestart centre. The ADPG is very close by so the Play area was removed.
Rathlin	Strip of land that separates the A23 from Broadfield neighbourhood. The old play area and pavilion was destroyed by fire and a new development of flats replaced it. However this has enhanced the site by providing visibility and security for and new play area which is well used and built in consultation with residents. Previously there was football at the site but this ceased with the removal of the pavilion although there is the possibility to use the changing rooms at the 3G pitch located by Broadfield stadium. The site has the conservation area of Broadfield flood pond and provides trails for walkers. There have previously been plans to develop this site for the Towns new fire station.
